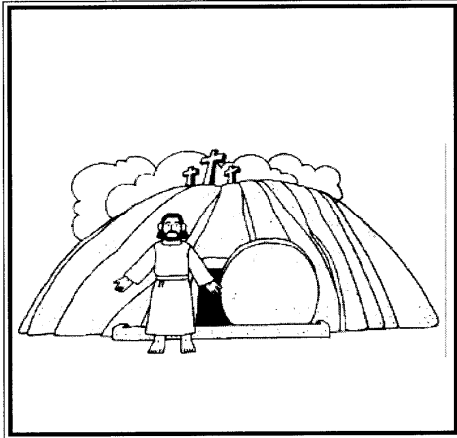
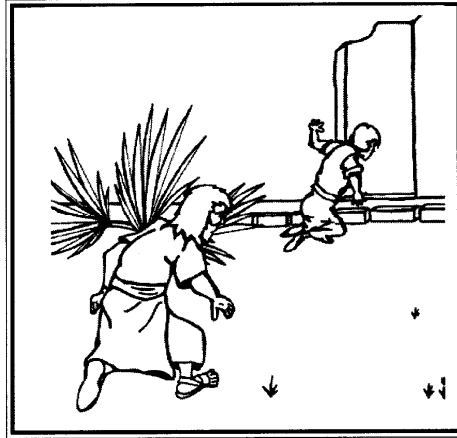

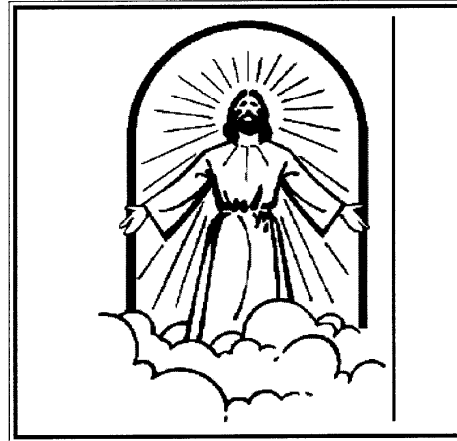
Jesus rose after he died on the cross

Heavenly Father, the empty tomb is no mystery to us. He is risen! We rejoice in his name. Amen.



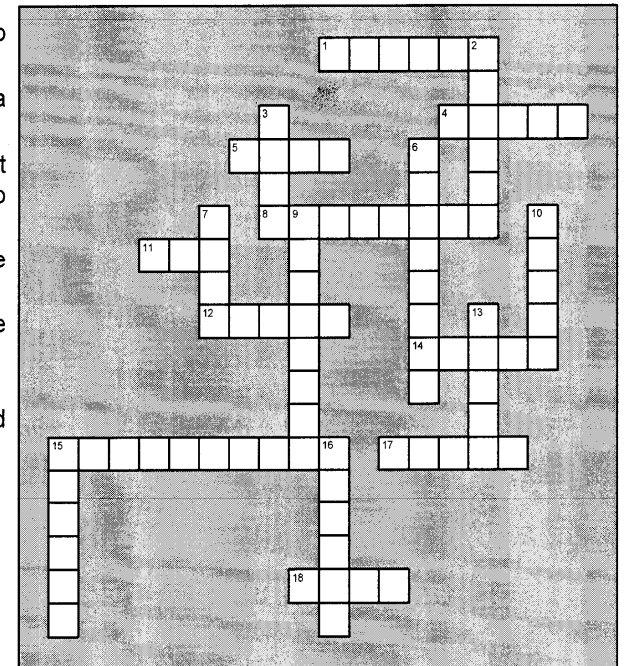
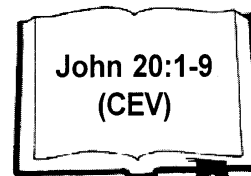
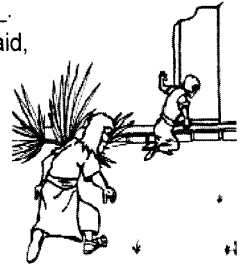

COULD HIS FOLLOWERS HAVE STOLEN HIS BODY?

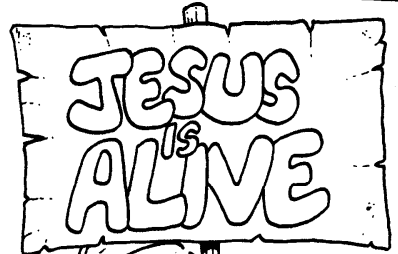
The Romans had put guards there and anyway, this Jesus was alive, not a corpse.

COULD THE WOMEN HAVE SEEN A GHOST?

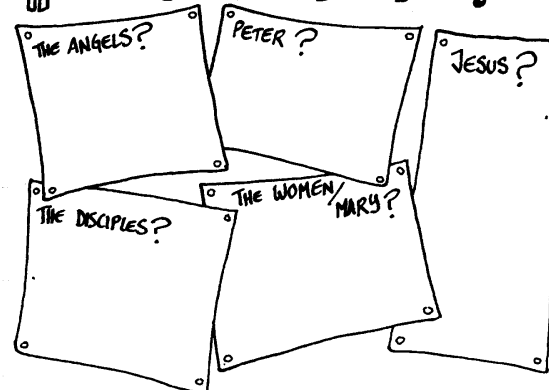
Mary mistook Jesus for a real person (the gardener) and was convinced it was Jesus who spoke to her, and who she touched.

BUT PEOPLE DON'T COME BACK TO LIFE!

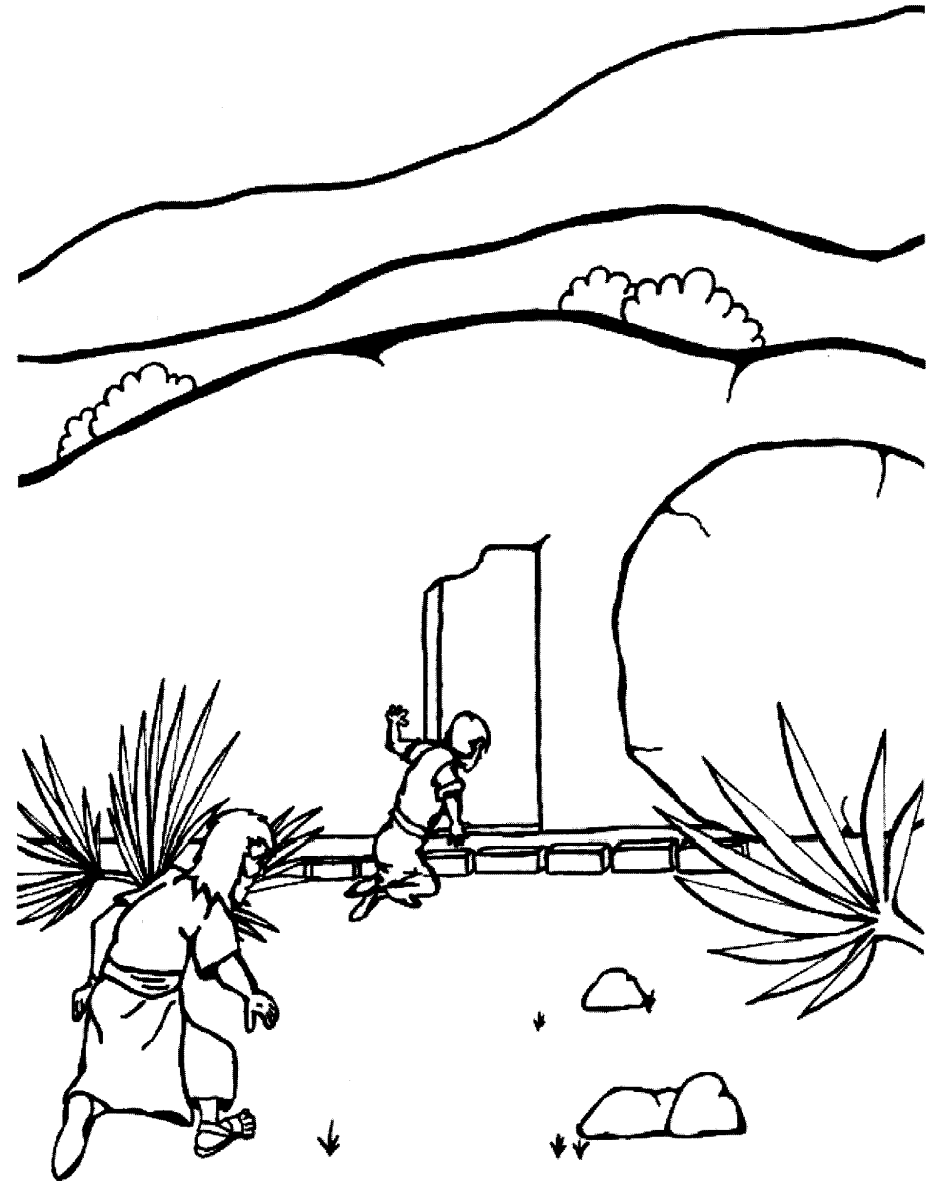
Exactly. We are bound to consider the possibility of Jesus really being the Son of God.

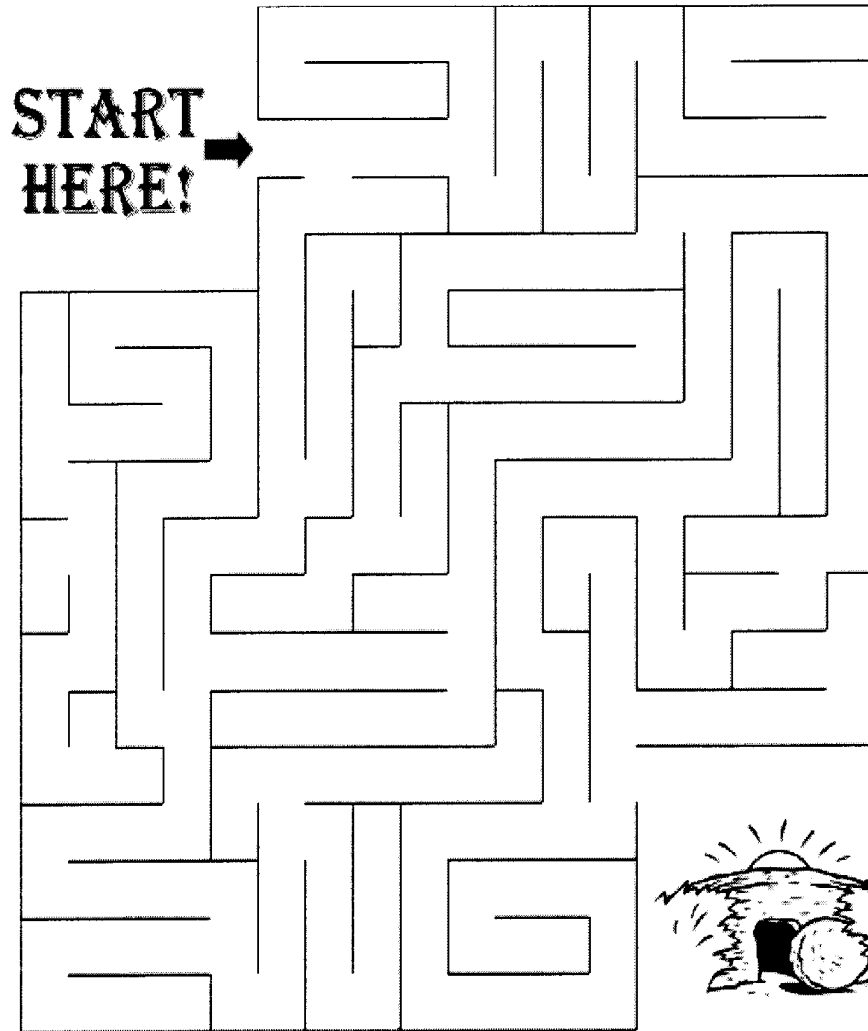
When Jesus was crucified, his friends were sad, but Easter made them glad.
