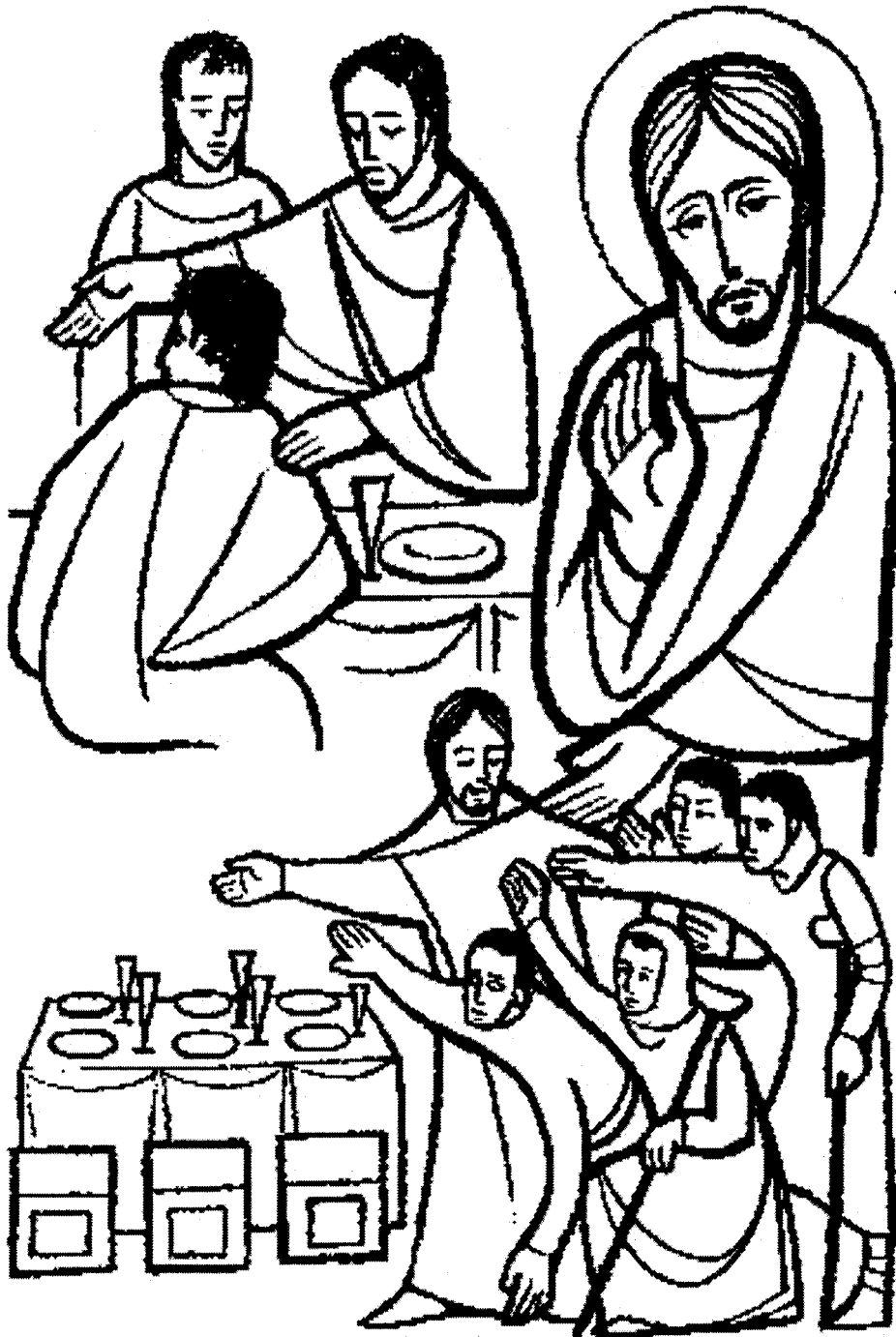
The Twelfth Sunday after Pentecost 28 August, 2022

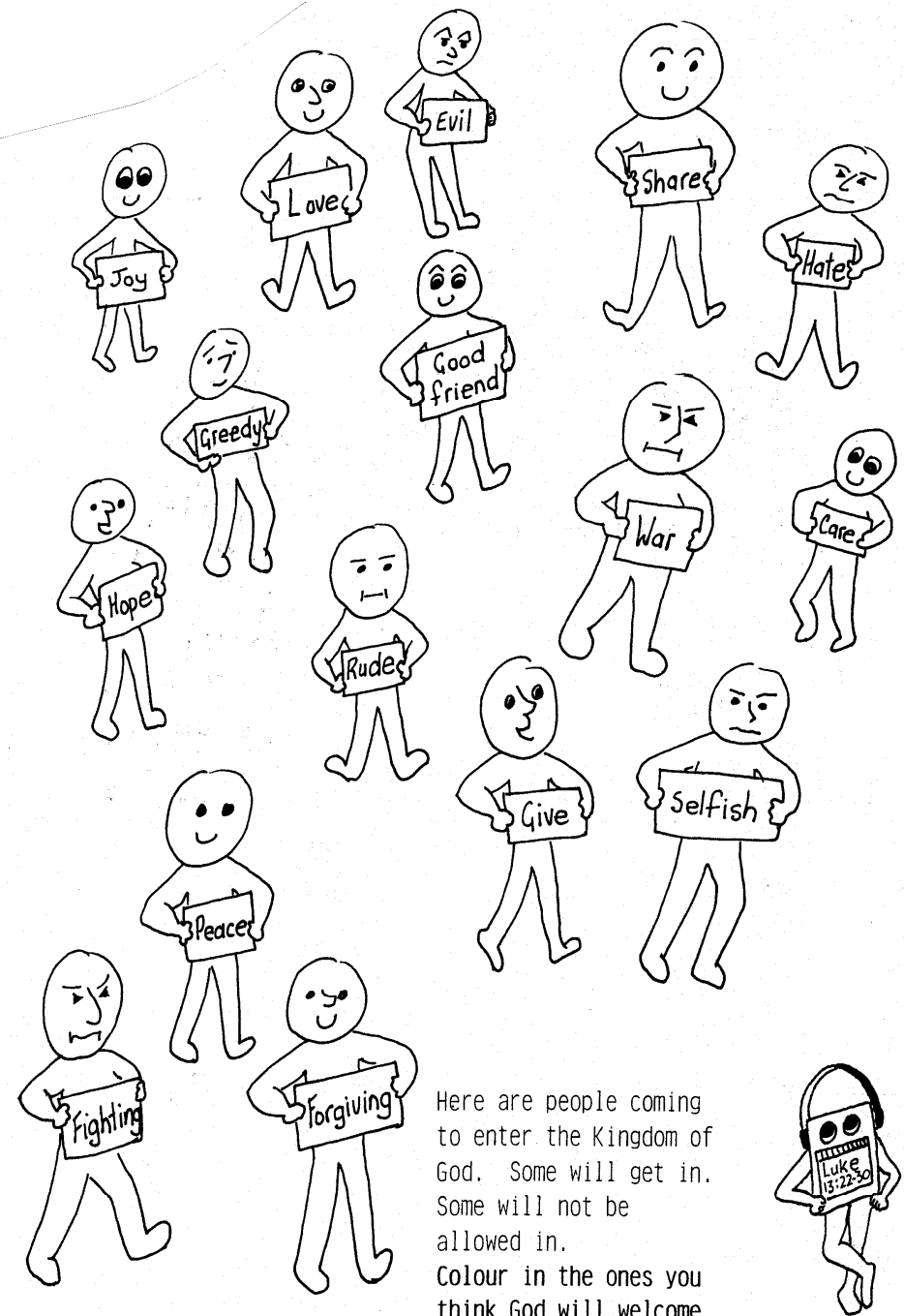

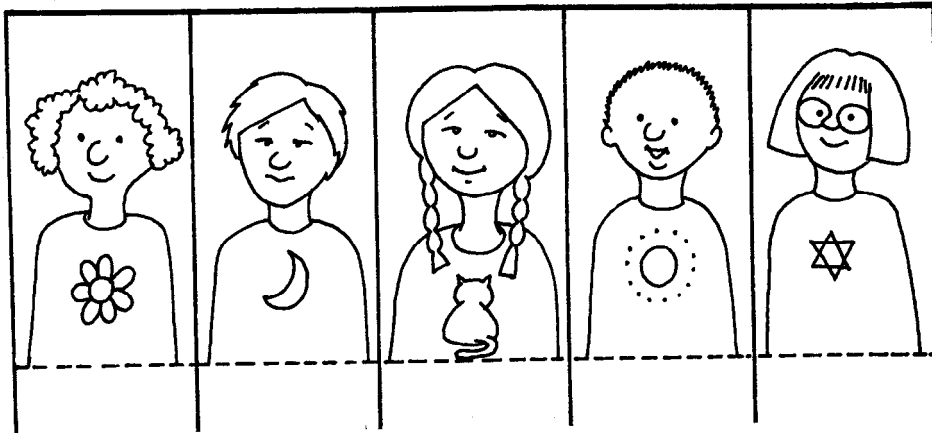

Here are people coming to enter the Kingdom of God. Some will get in. Some will not be allowed in. Colour in the ones you think God will welcome.

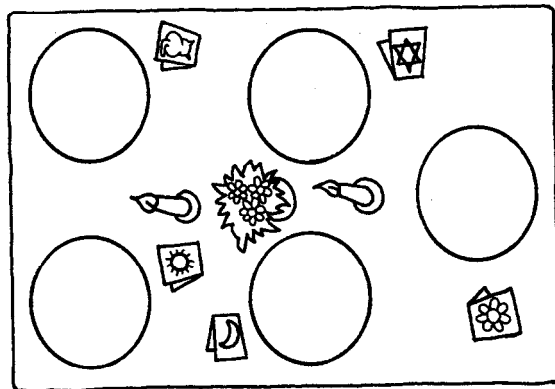


Colour the guests, cut them out and stick them at the right place for the party. Draw in their food.
