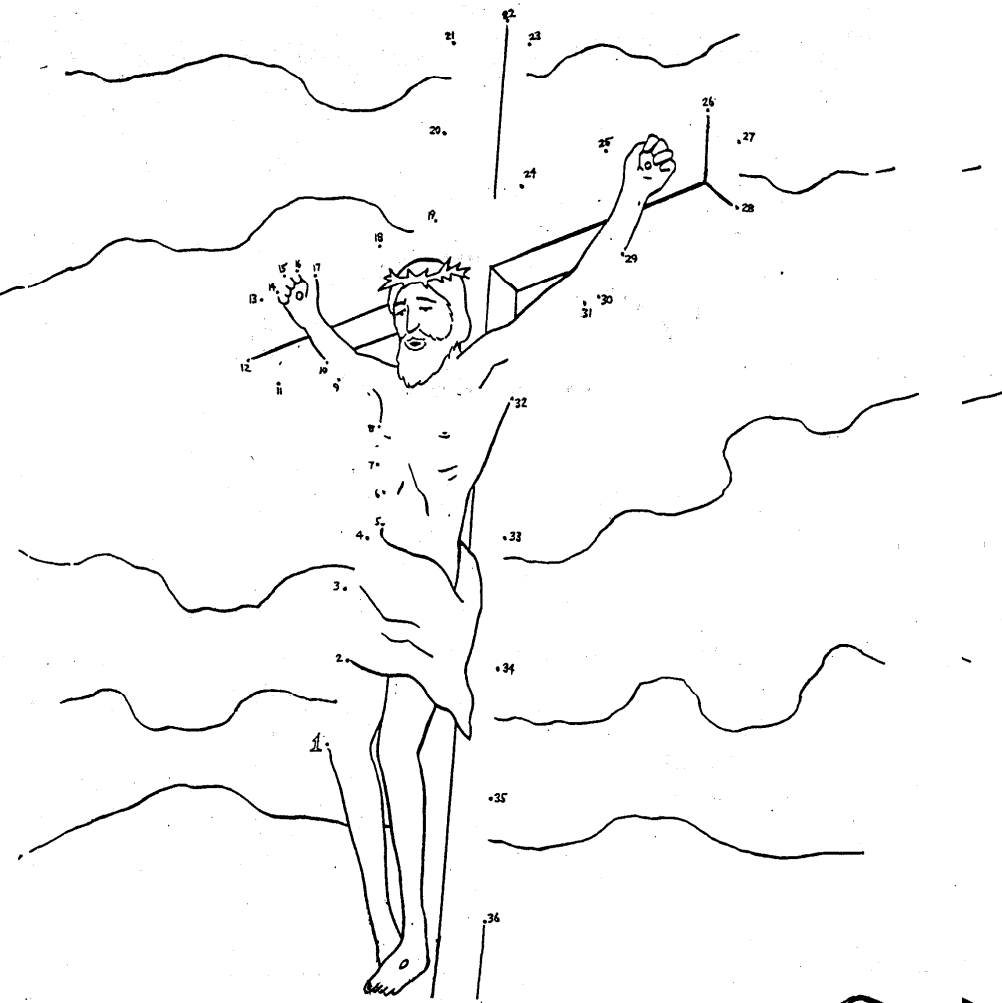
Jesus died on a cross. People laughed at him, calling him "The King of the Jews".

Draw Jesus on the cross wearing a crown of thorns.

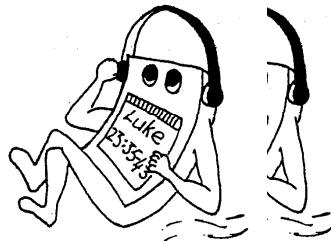
