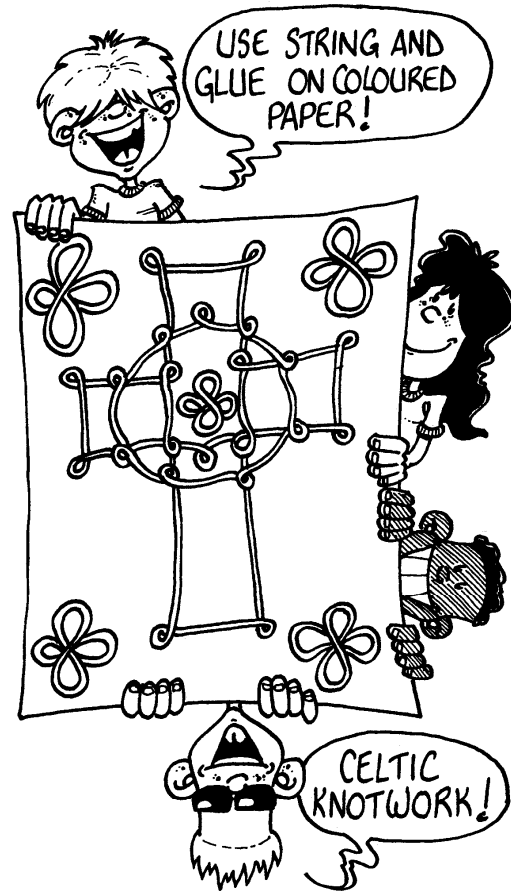
Heavenly Father, help us to guard against things that hurt others both in words and deeds; and forgive us as we ask those we have hurt to forgive us as well. Amen.

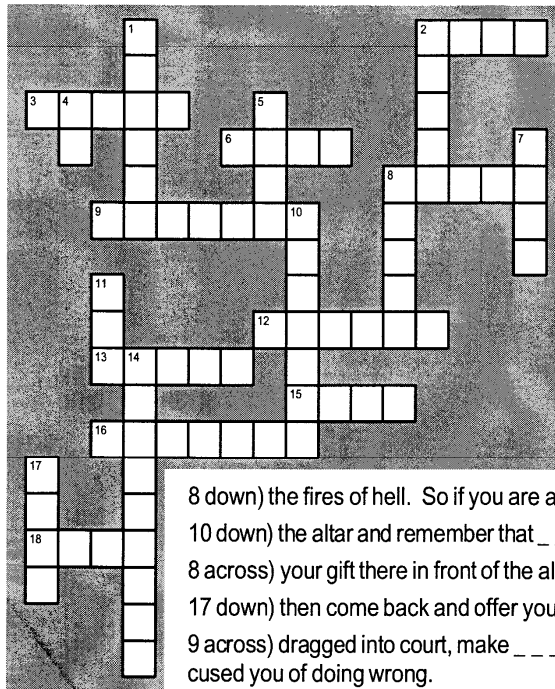

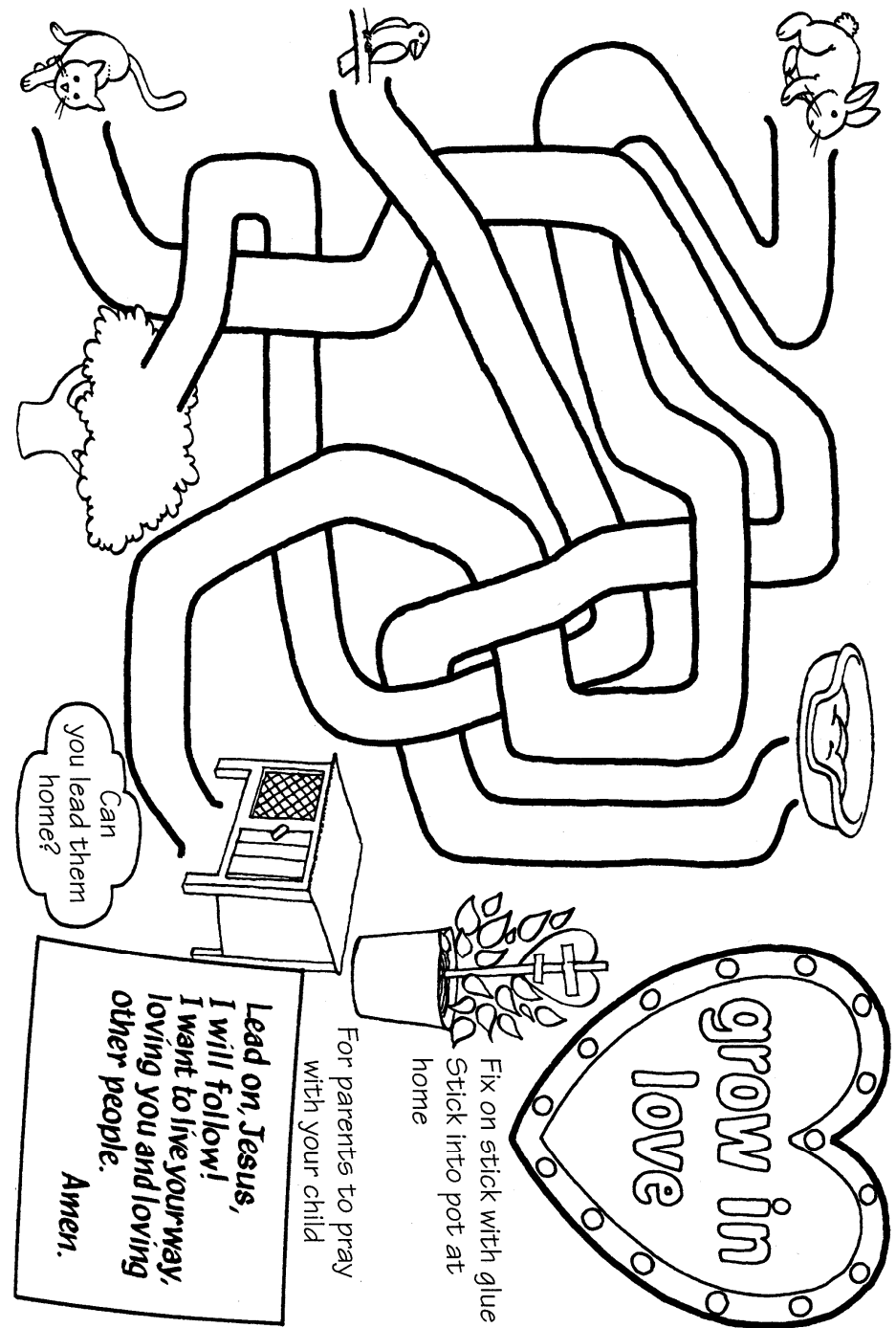


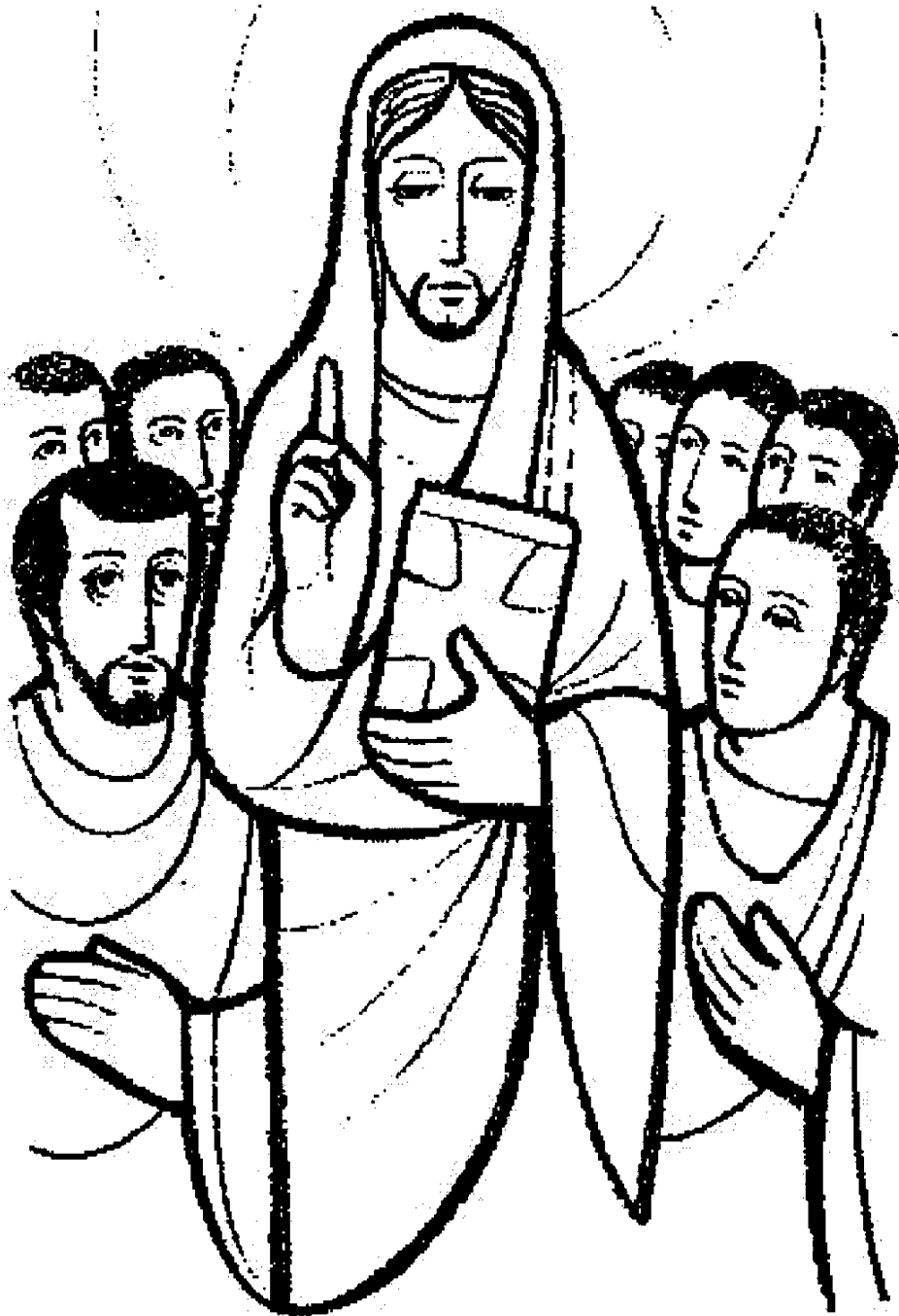
