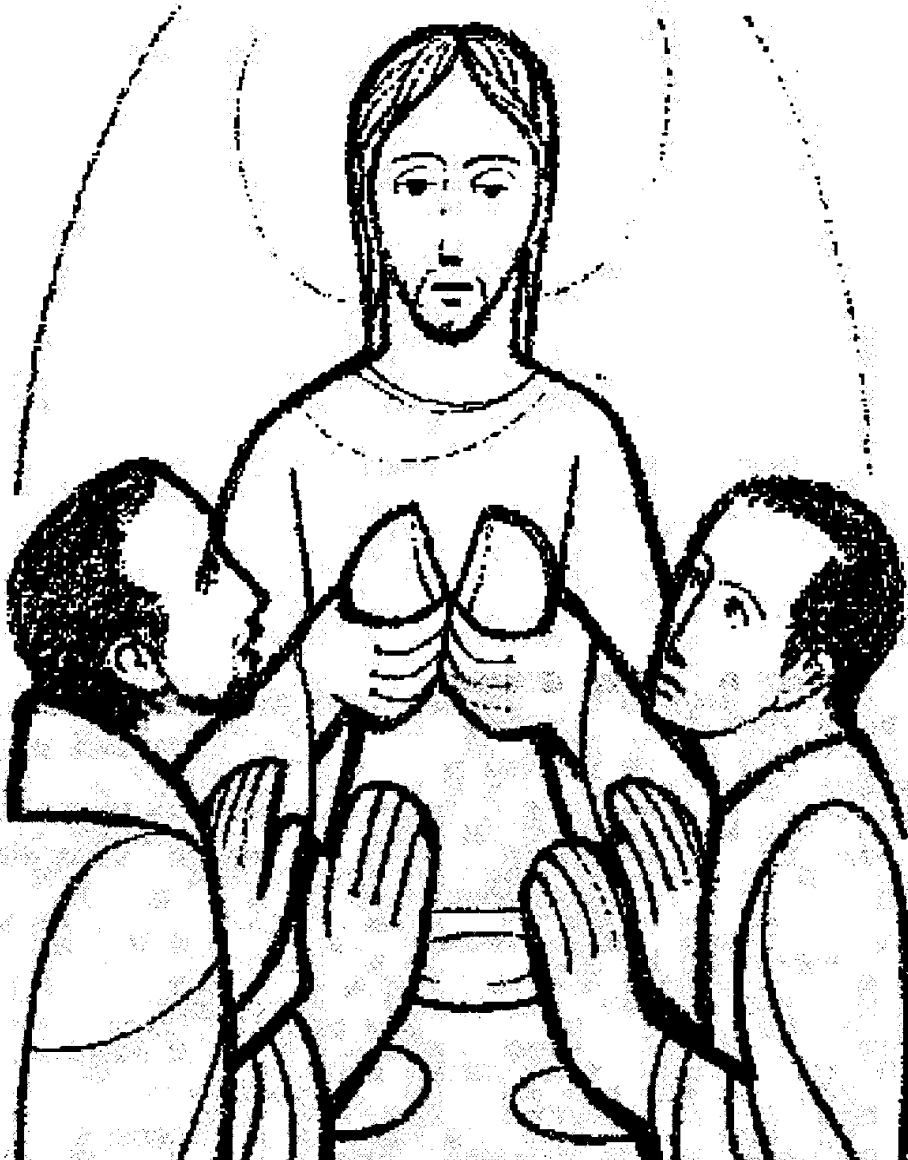

Father, we are thankful that as we travel along life's road, Jesus is walking with us and that he will help us see and understand the things that happen in our life. **Amen.**

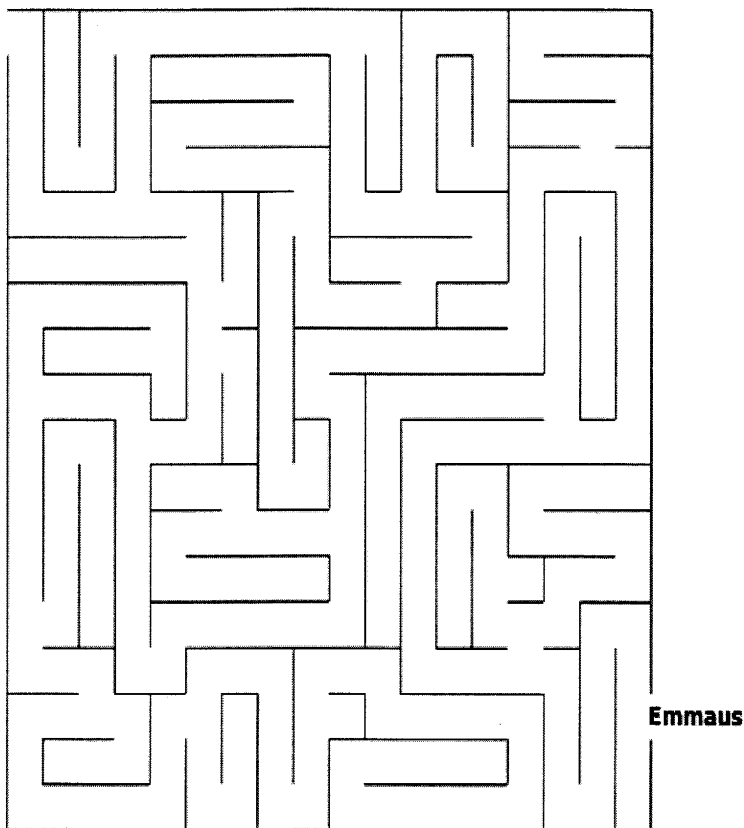
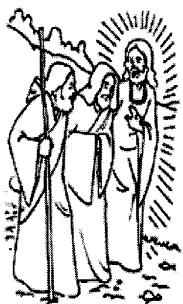


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On the Road to Emmaus

 Luke 24:13, 15(NLT)



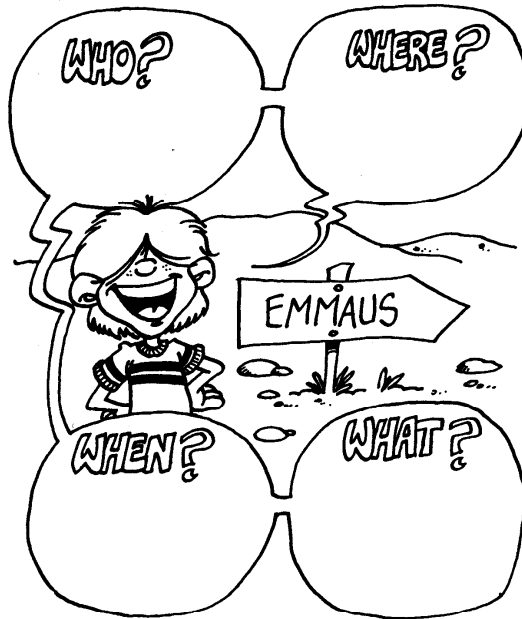

WHY DIDN'T HE TELL THEM WHO HE WAS?

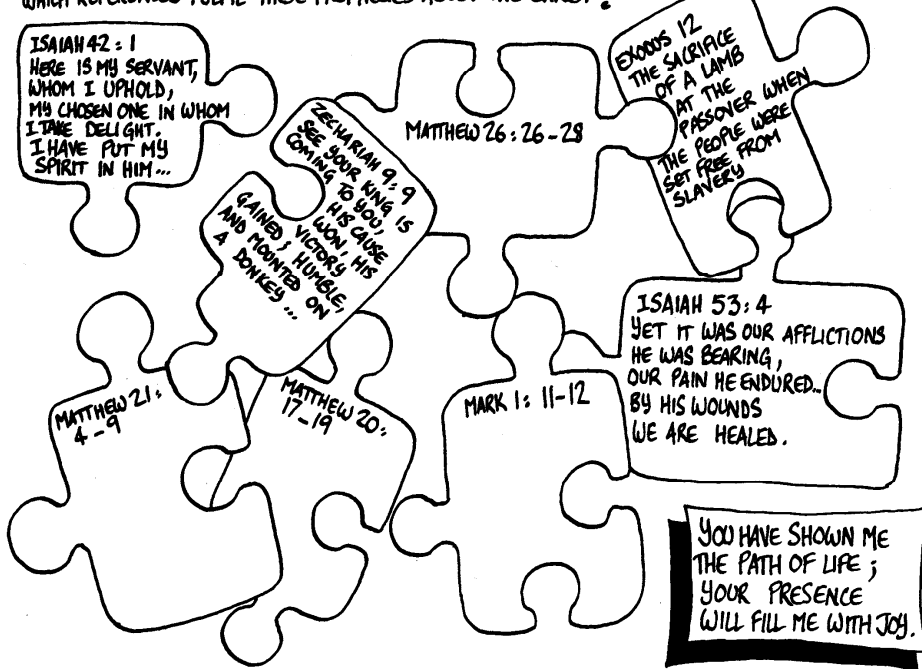
He was like a teacher, drawing them on by questions to drop into the answer for themselves.

WHY WAS IT THE BREAD-BREAKING THAT CRACKED IT FOR THEM?

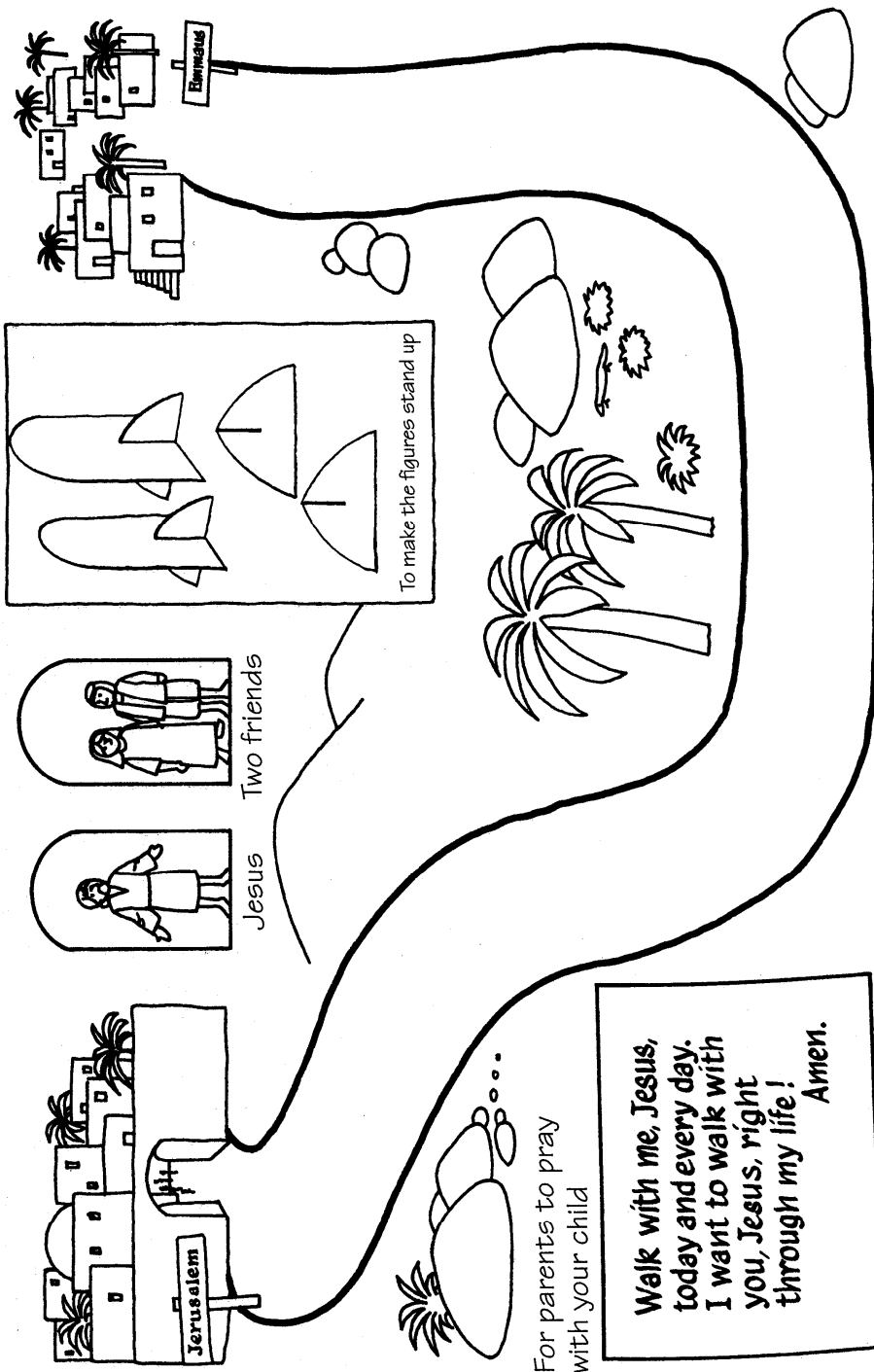
They remembered the way Jesus had done that before, and perhaps suddenly understood the last supper.

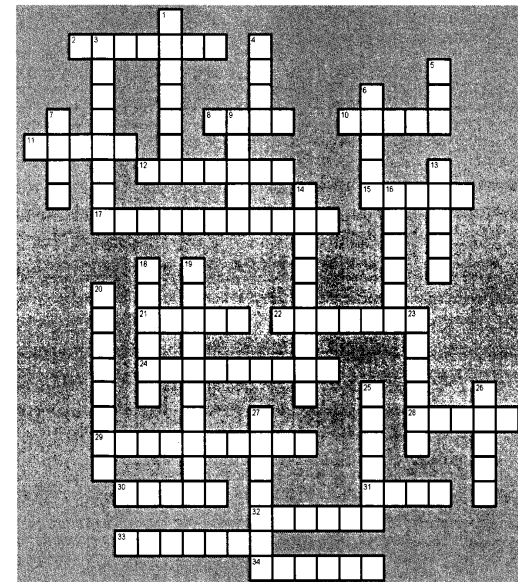
