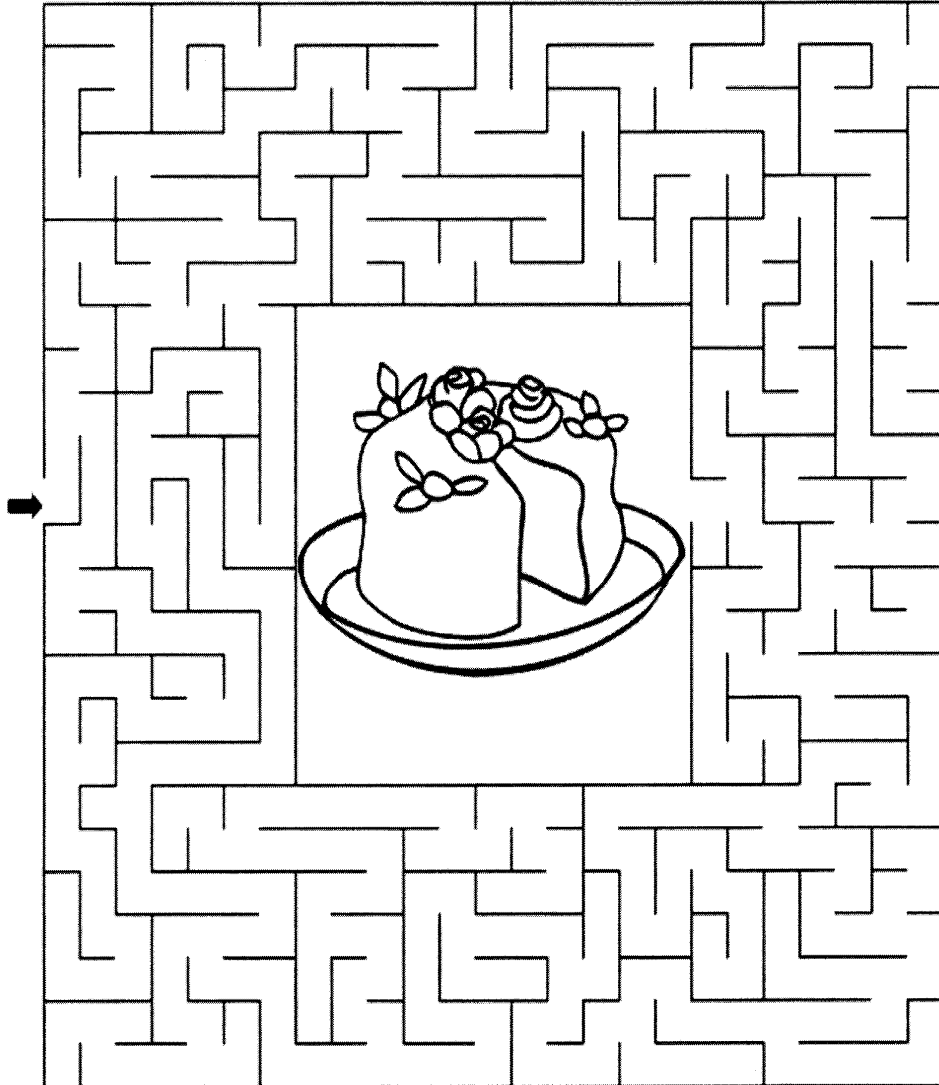
Matthew, 22:8-10

WHY WAS THE GUEST TOLD OFF FOR NOT WEARING A WEDDING GARMENT?

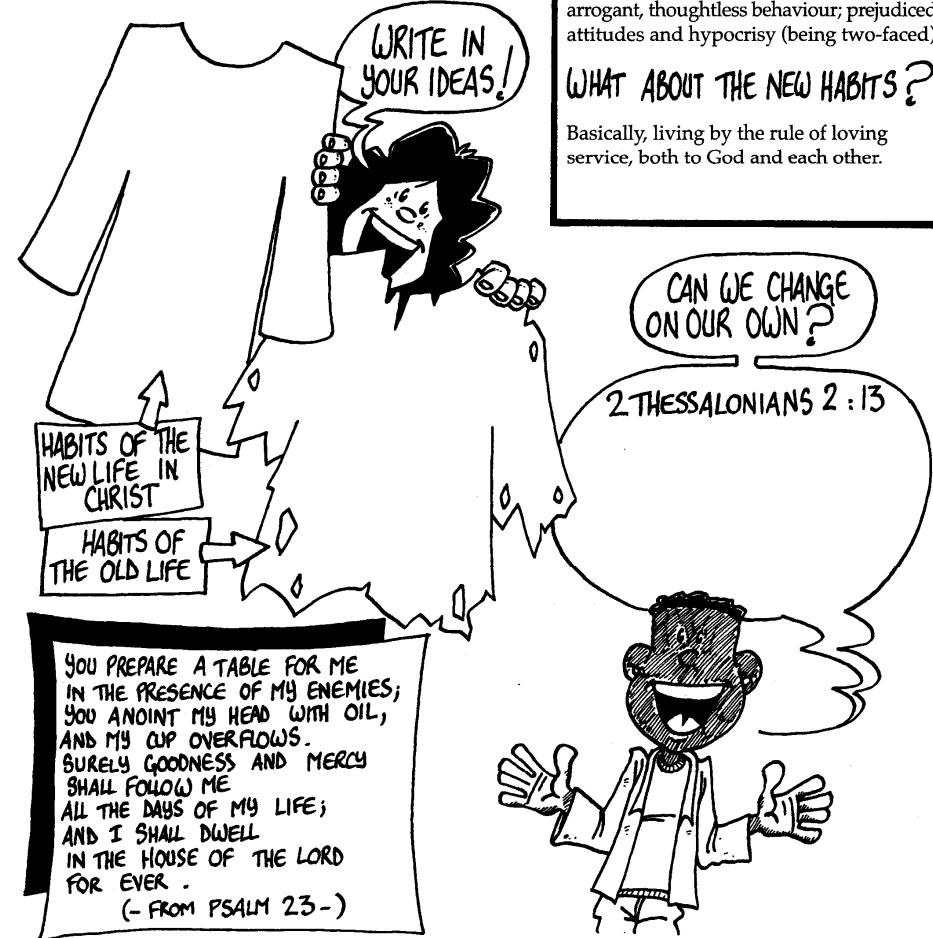
You would be given it, free, to wear in the palace, just as Jesus gives us new life. If we then choose to wear our old 'habits' instead, it insults God's love to us.

WHAT ARE THE OLD HABITS?

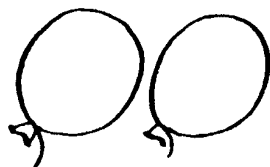
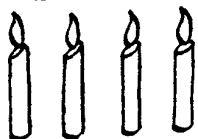
