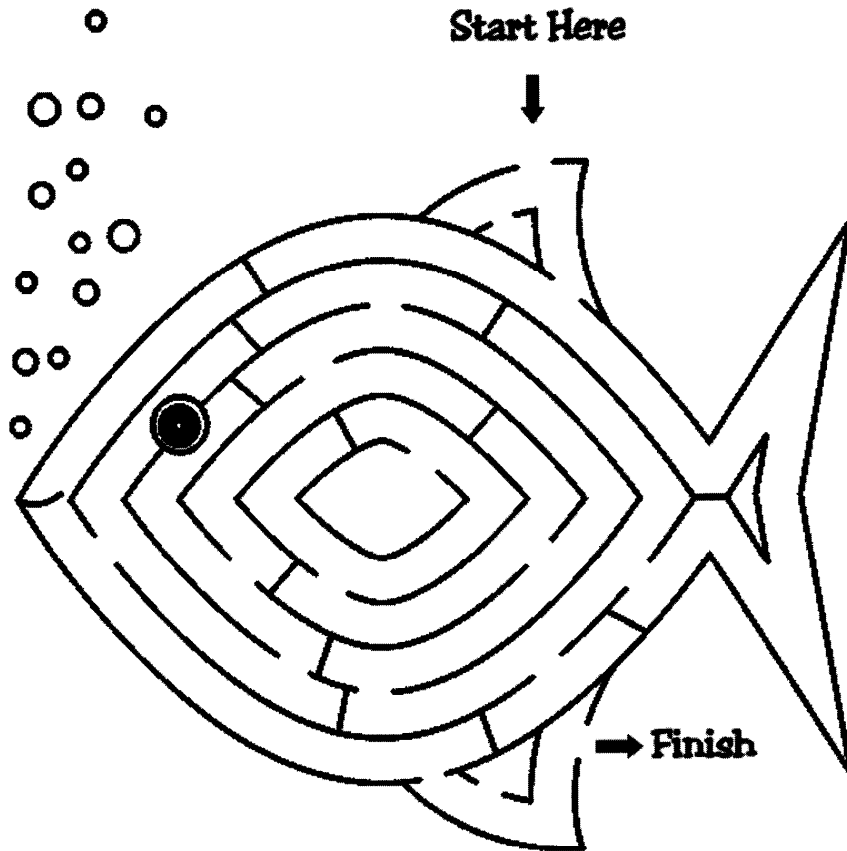
Mark 1:16-18

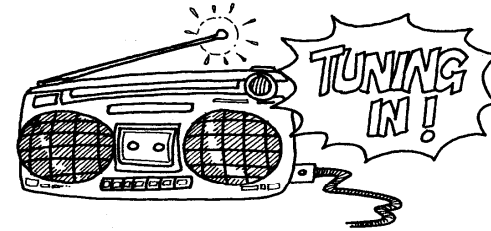

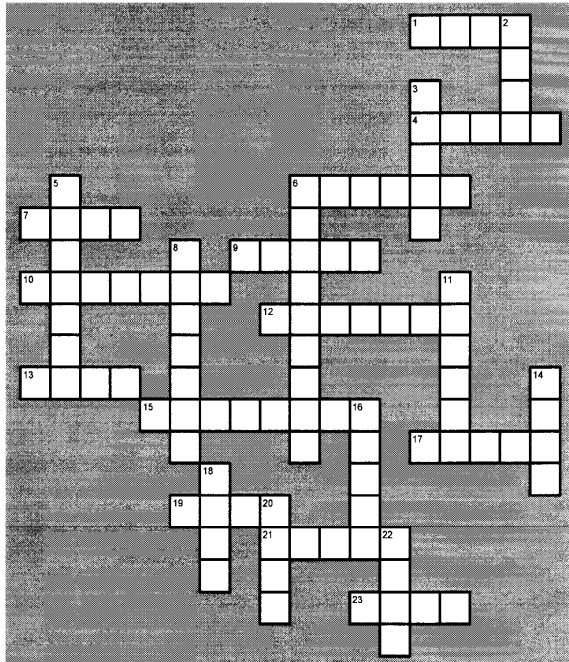

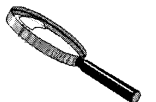
