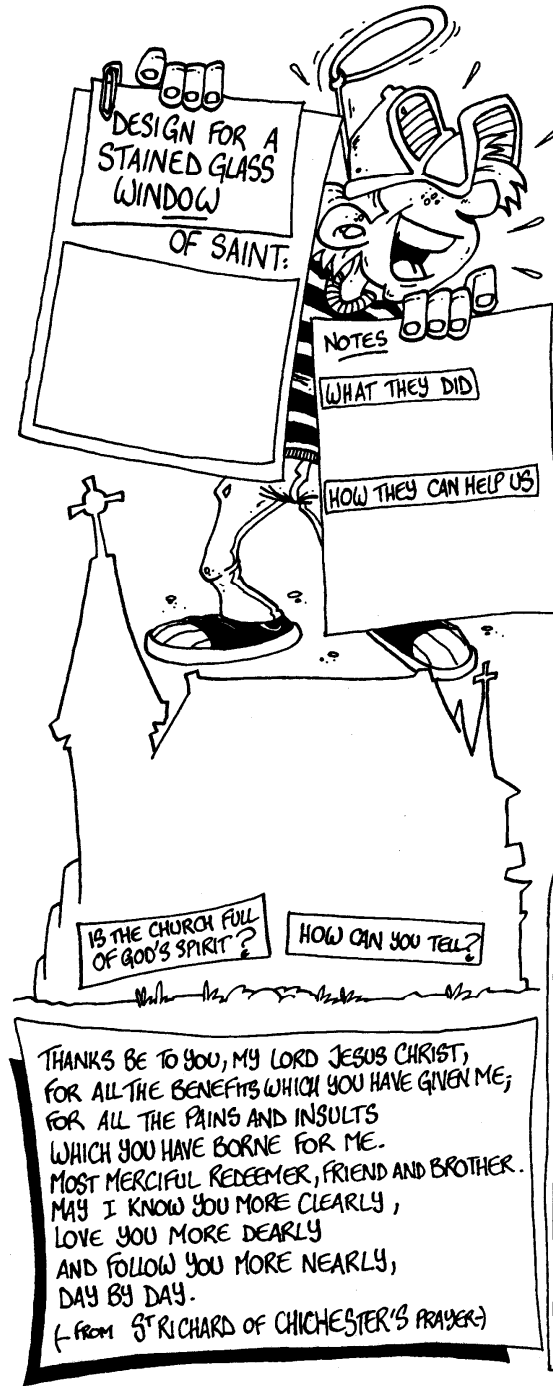


All Saints Sunday 3 November, 2024

That's right. In Christ we are all called to be filled with God's Spirit and live in his strength. Saints are people who do this. In the Bible the people of God in the Church are sometimes called 'the saints of God'.

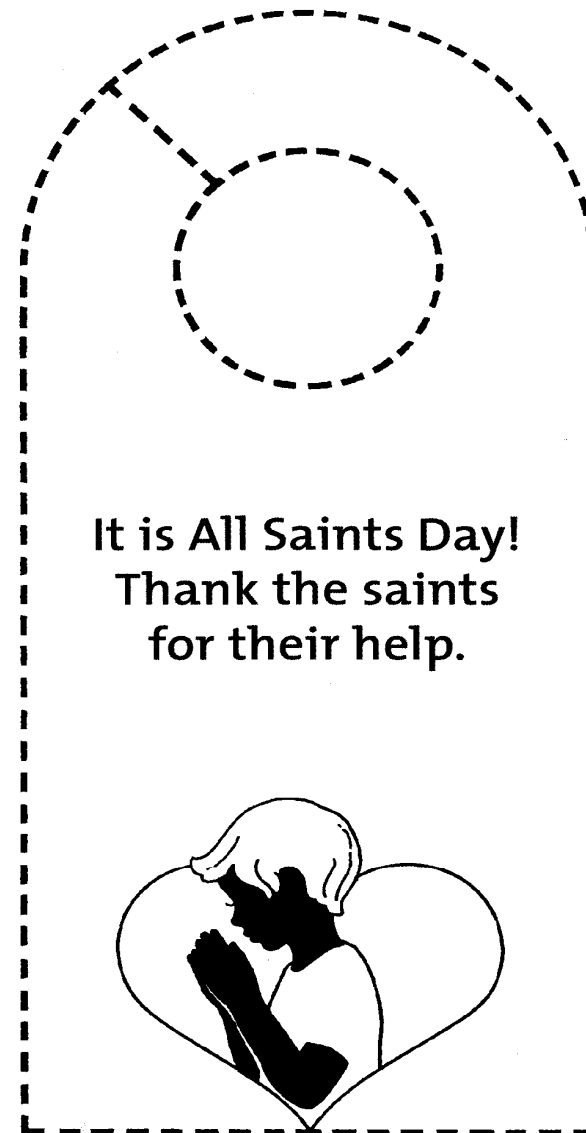

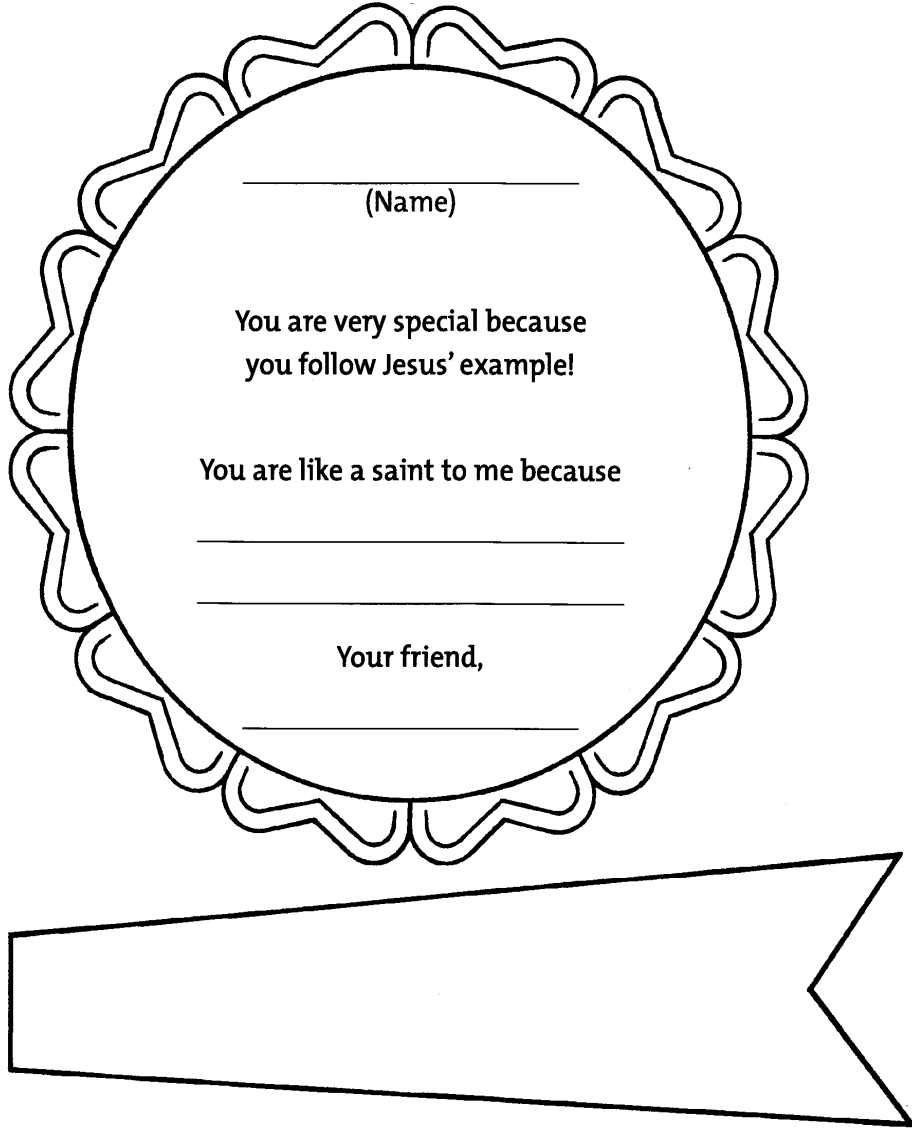

3. Hang it on your door to remind you to thank the saints on All Saints Day!



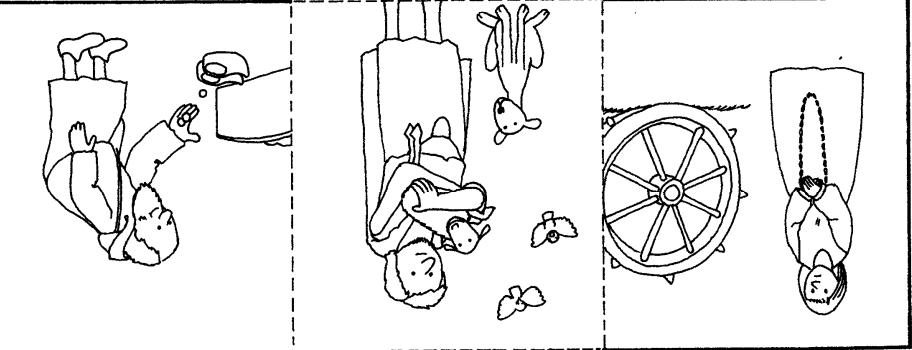
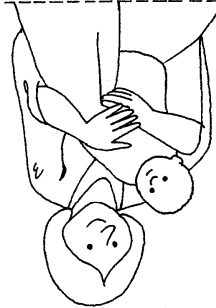
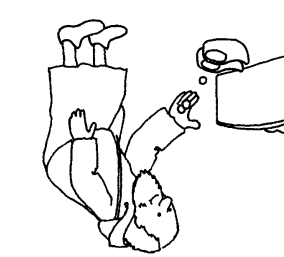

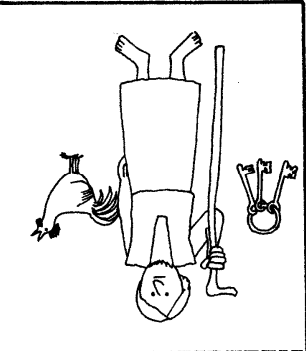
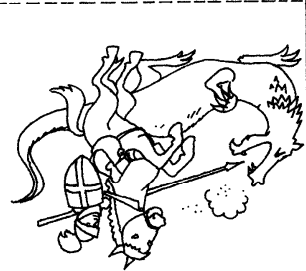
Colour the pictures, then fold up like this:

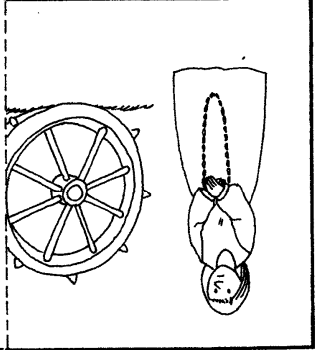
Tuck 5 round the back of 0 and draw on the title: **SAINTS ARE FILLED WITH GOD'S LOVE.**
