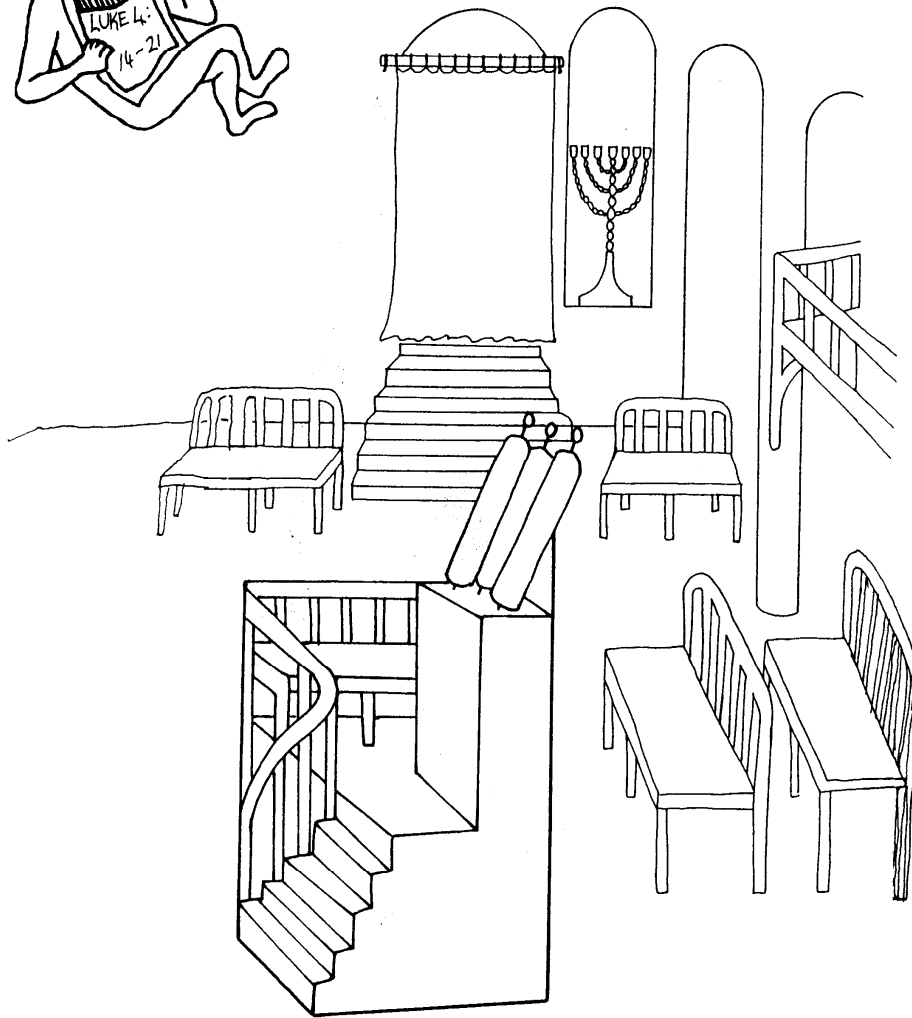

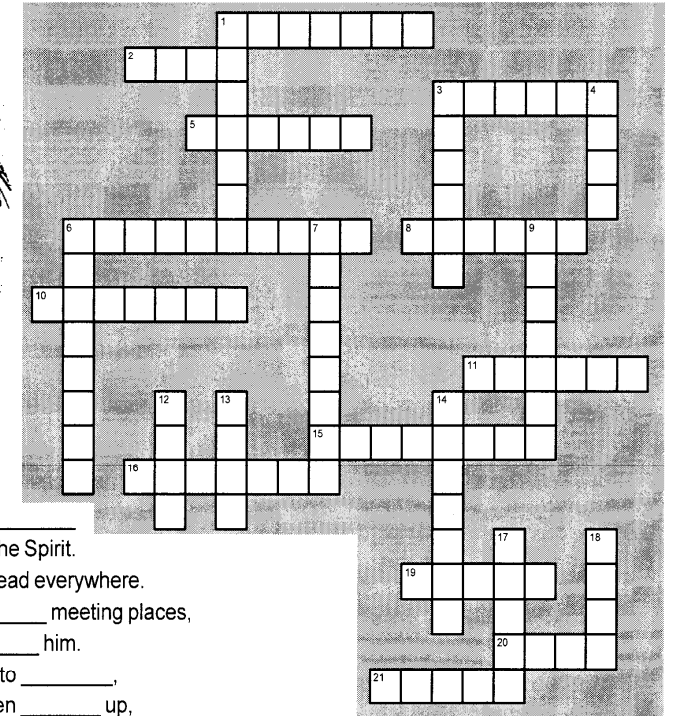


Draw Jesus reading the scroll in the synagogue. The words on the scroll said what Jesus would do.
