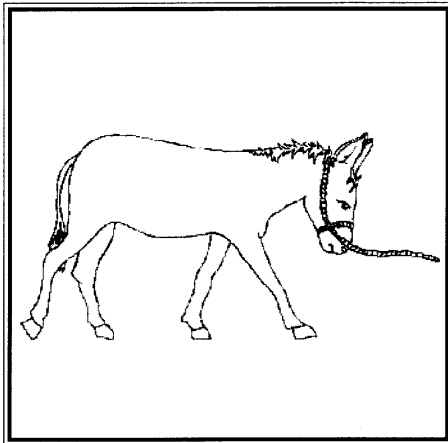


Do you know about Holy Week?

Color the pictures and learn about the last week before the first Easter. Ask your parents to help tell the story to you this week.



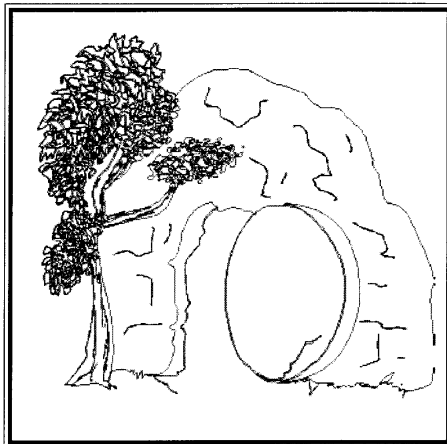

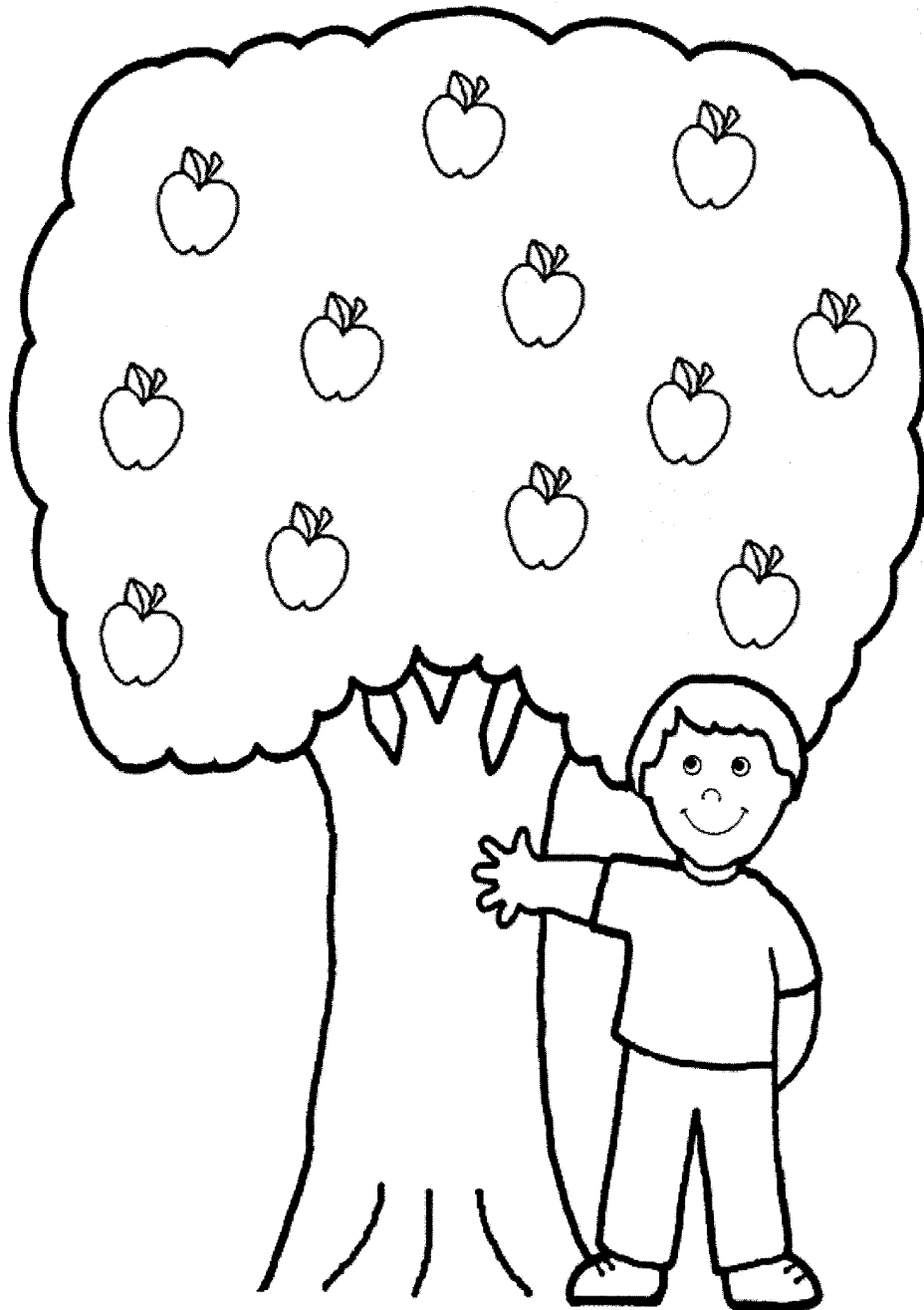


The Second Sunday in Lent 16 March, 2025

Heavenly Father, we know that you expect good things from your children. Help us live a life that will be pleasing to you. **Amen**

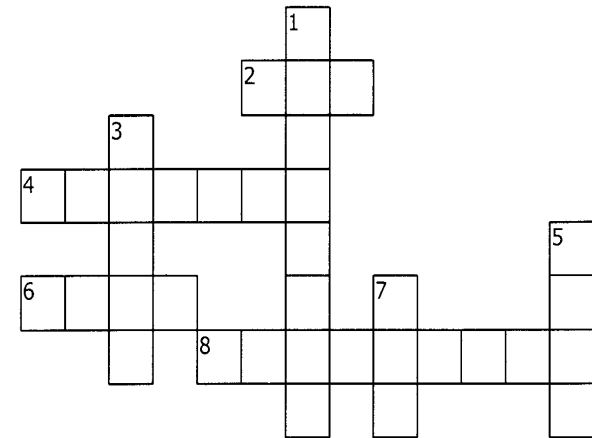
