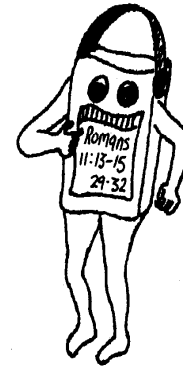


The Twelfth Sunday after Pentecost 16 August, 2026

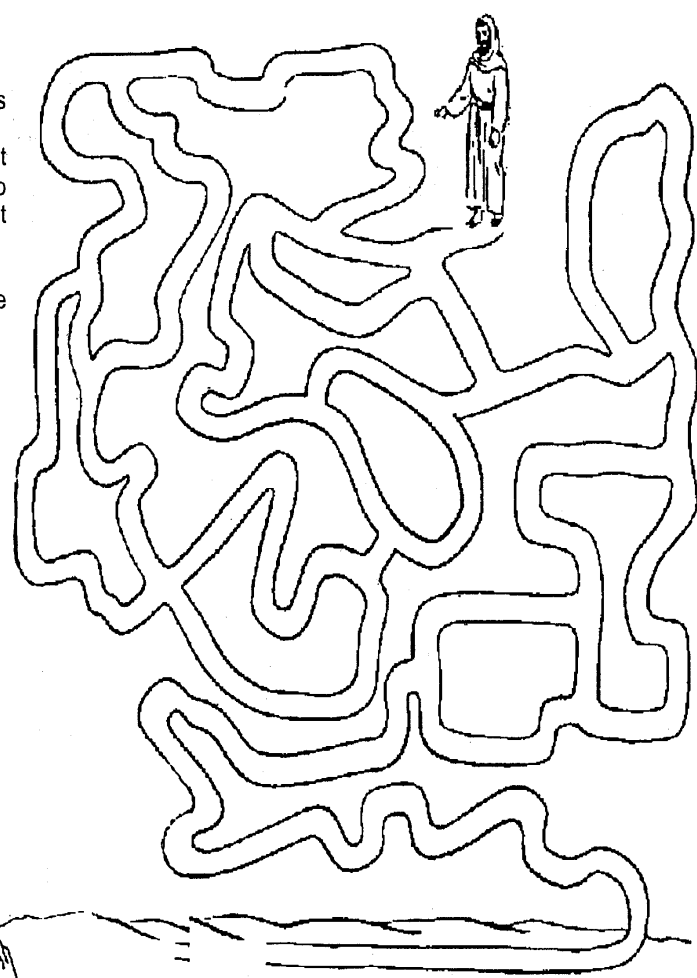
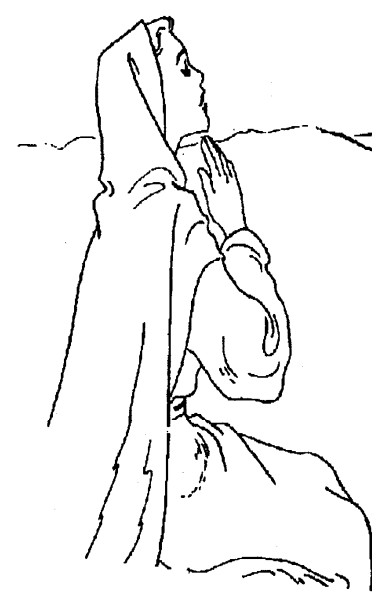

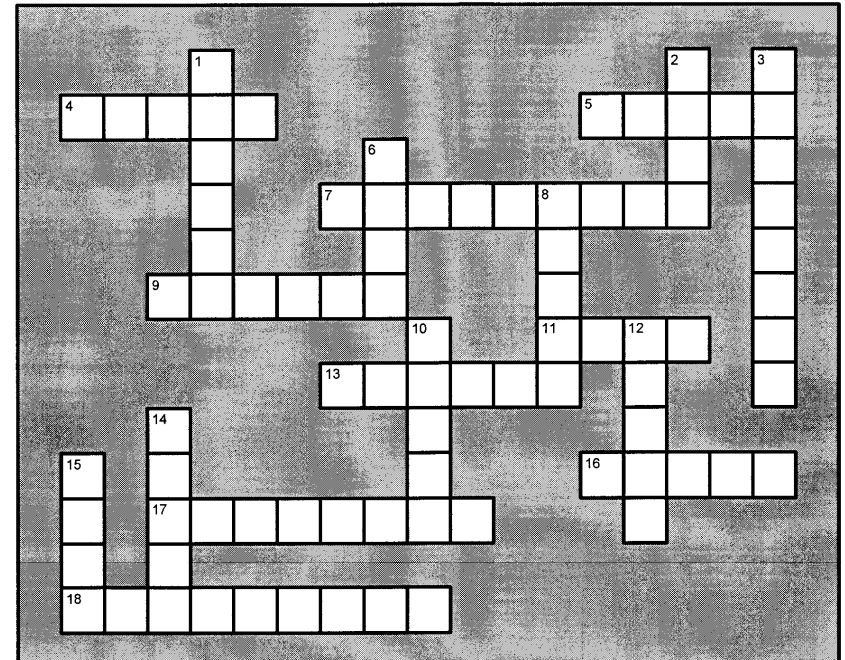
