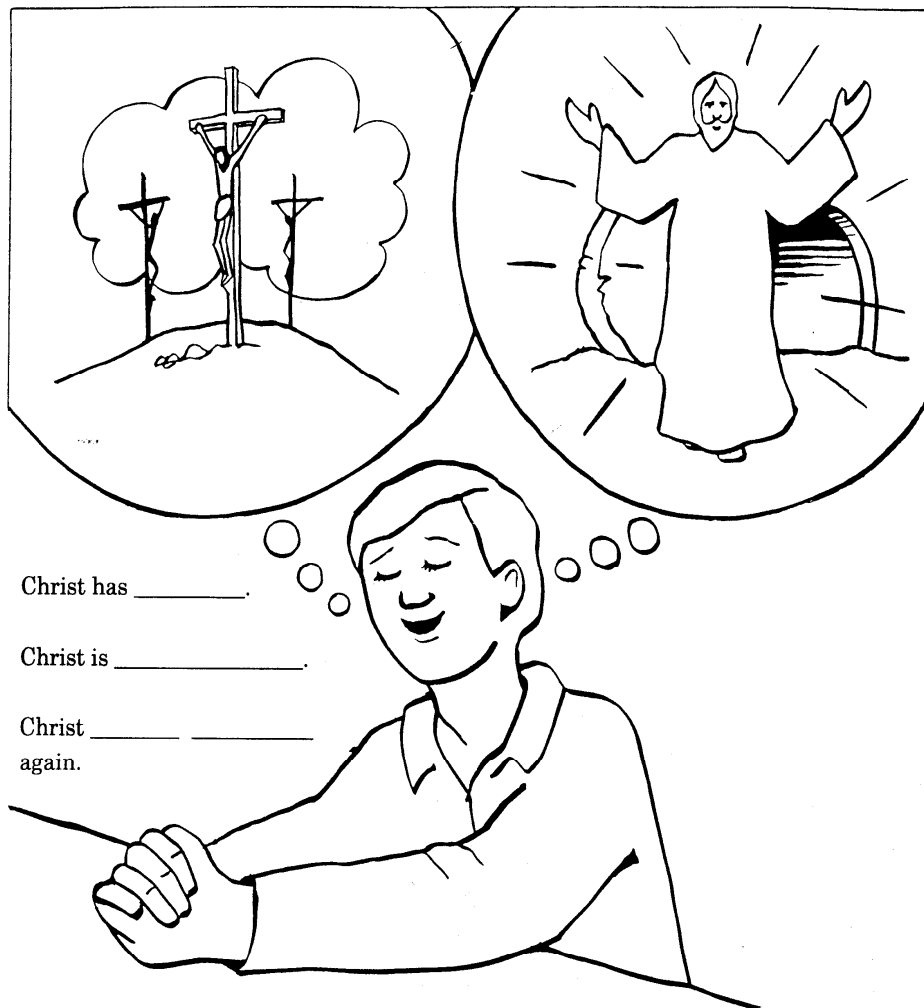

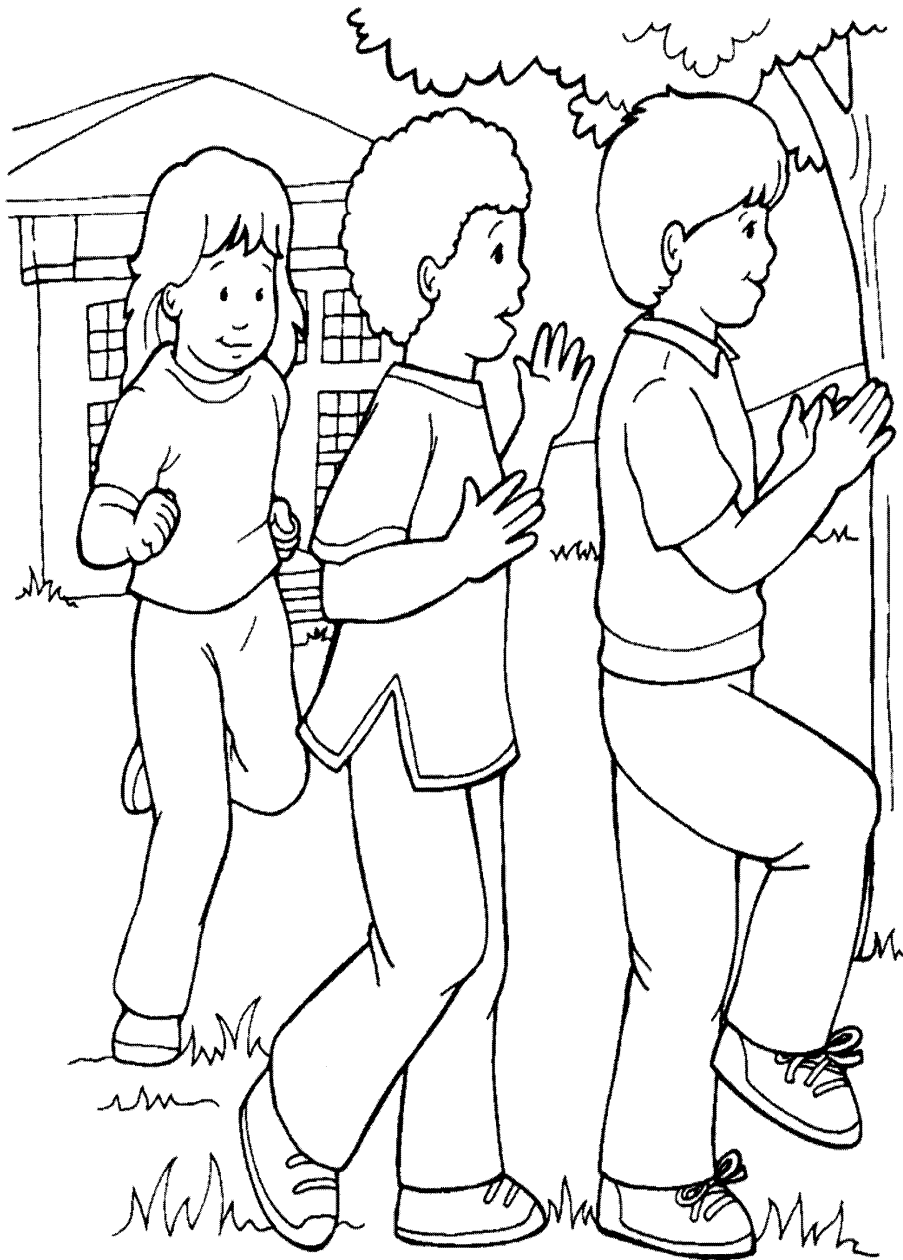

Jesus, help us to be all that you want us to be. Help us through the hard times we have, so that we can enjoy the happy times that you give to us. **Amen**



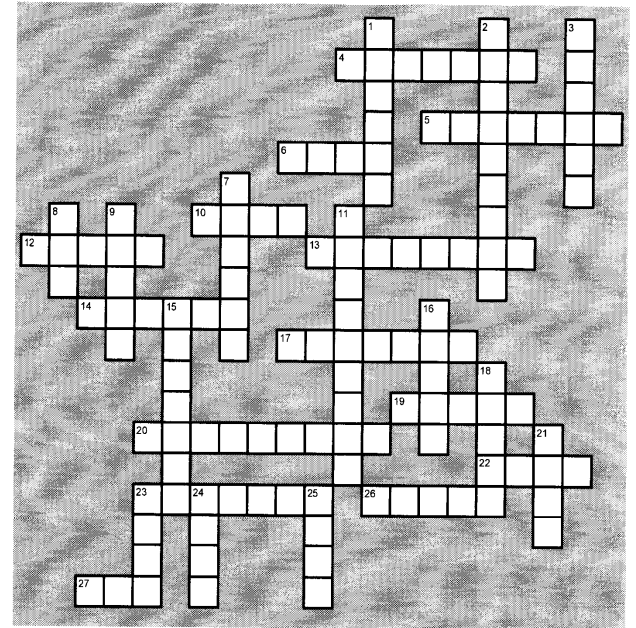
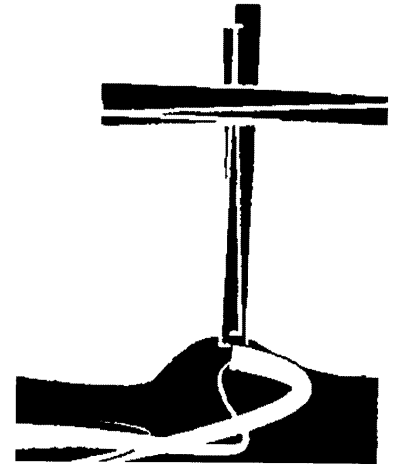
