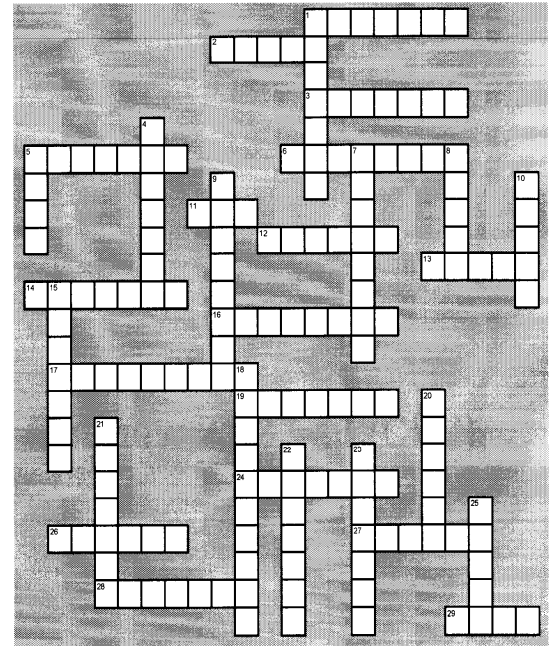

 don't want to see.

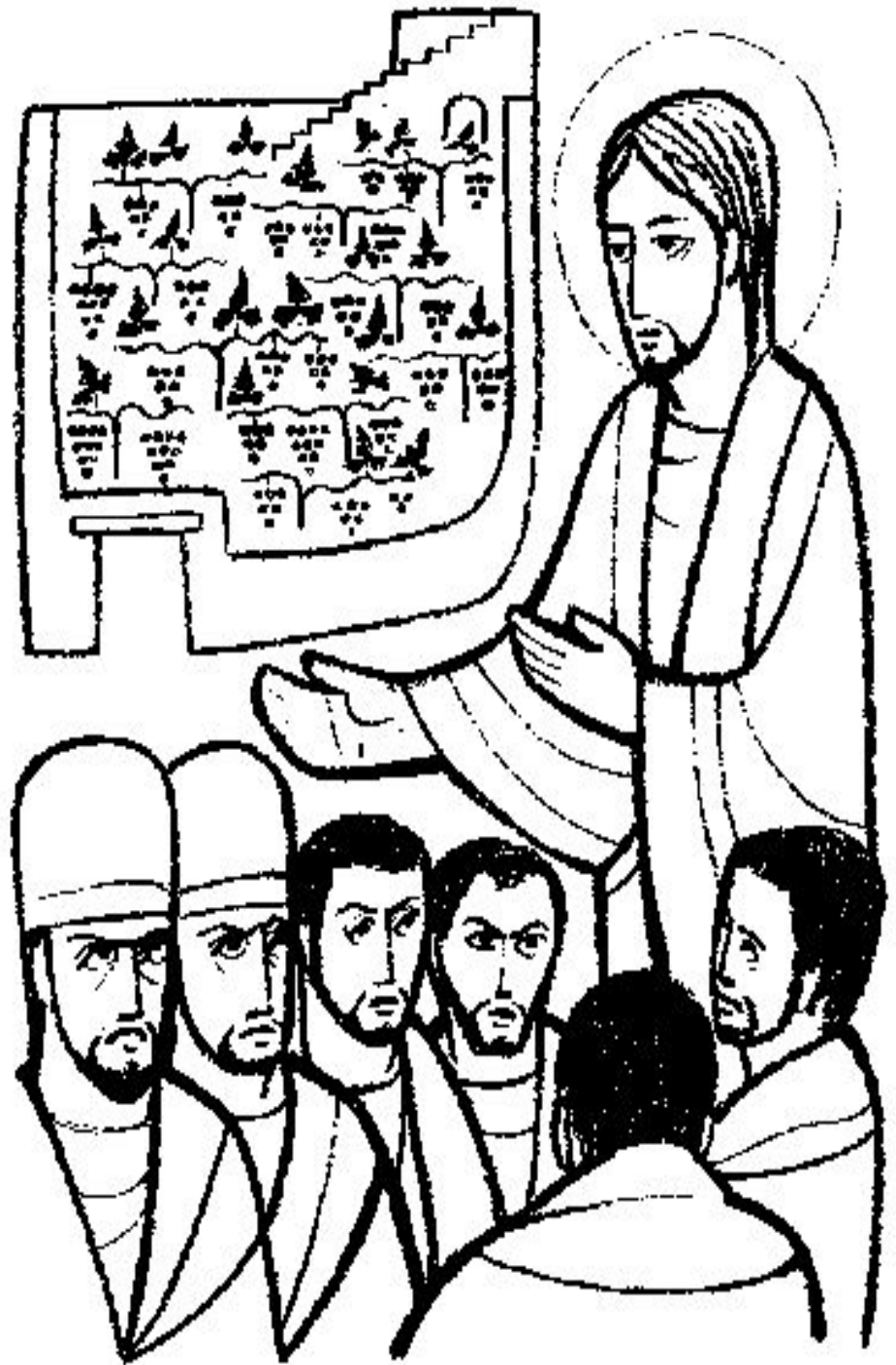
